### **Glazing (Layering Color) in Watercolor**

Second, since watercolor pigments are resoluble, even when dry, care must be taken when glazing not to use a “heavy” hand in other words, the paint should just flow off the brush, and you should use very little pressure, so as not to disturb the underlying layers of paint A very soft brush is also a requirement

my watercolor paper with an acrylic gesso This pre-gesso preparation process seals the paper from absorbing the paint and varnish Keep in mind this technique is a nontraditional way of preparing a watercolor painting In other words, the paint remains and dries on the top gesso surface When the painting has dried, I apply an oil varnish
